of the County of Middlesex County and State
of Tennessee being of sound mind and
memory do make this my last will and testament
(last)

after all my just debts are paid I leave
to my beloved wife all my estate both real
and personal during her natural life:

I give to my own children Charlotte G Seales
George G Seales Samuel Seales Nicholas Seales
Noah Seales Jane Bullenford & Nancy Seales

the proceeds of the tract of land on which I
now live containing three hundred & twenty acres
each to share of them alike except my son Samuel
Seales who is to receive twenty five dollars less

than the rest in consequence of money advanced to
him as so much of his estate share of my estate

I give to my daughter Charlotte G Seales a negro girl
Delia as compensation for her domestic services over
and above the rest of my children and have executed
a bill of sale to her for a negro. I also give to

my daughter Charlotte a negro worth four hundred
dollars or that amount in cash to make her equal
to make her equal to the rest of my children

my son John Seales has received a tract of land
which is considered as equivalent to one share of the
seven parts of the tract on which I live & a negro
worth four hundred dollars as given to Charlotte above

and all the rest of my children have received a
negro a piece now at the death of my wife it is
my will that the balance of my estate not here
fore divided be equally divided among all my
children as follows to wit) Charlott G Sealy John
Sealy Samuel Sealy Joseph G Sealy Nicholas
Sealy Jane Pollock of Cook Sealy of Maryland
Scamper to them and their heirs for ever

I now constitute and appoint my son John
Sealy of Cook Sealy executor to this my
last will and testimony given under my hand
and seal this third day of July one thousand
eight hundred and thirty three signed & sealed
in the presence of us
